SEQRA RESOLUTION

BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS PORT WASHINGTON POLICE DISTRICT

Negative Declaration for an Unlisted Action Under SEQRA
for the Port Washington Police District

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Port Washington Police District (the “District”) is proposing to construct a police headquarters; and

WHEREAS, upon a coordinated review, the District was selected to be the Lead Agency for Purposes of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and

WHEREAS, the Proposed Action includes the construction of a new police headquarters as more fully described in the attached Negative Declaration”; and

WHEREAS, given the nature and scope of these activities, the District has determined that the project is an Unlisted Action as that term is defined within SEQRA; and

WHEREAS, the Full Environmental Assessment Form (FEAF) Parts 1, 2 and 3 have been prepared to assess the potential for environmental impacts; and

WHEREAS, the District has examined the FEAF Parts 1, 2 and 3 and based on information contained within them, has determined that this action will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts that would require the preparation of a Draft Environmental Impact Statement; and

WHEREAS, a Negative Declaration has been prepared pursuant to Section 617 of the SEQRA regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Commissioners of the Port Washington Police District hereby adopts the Negative Declaration (copy attached) and that the SEQRA review is therefore complete.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately



upon its adoption by the Board of Police Commissioners of the Port Washington Police District. The question of the adoption of the foregoing resolution was duly put to a vote on roll call, which resulted as follows:
