

PROPOSED RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO BROTHERS POLICE STORE FROM ASSET FORFEITURE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Port Washington Police District (the “District”) has a “Crime Prevention Fund” (the “Fund”) in which the proceeds of federal asset forfeiture money received by the District is on deposit; and

WHEREAS, the District requires certain funds to be utilized in connection with payment for uniforms, including but not limited to shirts, jackets, and nametapes (the “Uniforms”), from Brothers Police Store, 644 Horseblock Road, Farmingville, New York; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the Uniforms is Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$9,295.00); and

WHEREAS, the District desires to pay such cost with money drawn from the Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the District draw from the Fund the sum of Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$9,295.00), for such purpose, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Police Commissioners of the Port Washington Police District.
